Pool Season Is Here!

The Pool opening party is Saturday, May 27 starting at 11:00 a.m. Food, games, and DJ. Please remember that no glass containers are ever allowed in the pool facility. Take a moment to review the Brooktree pool rules as we have made some changes.

Children must be 14 to enter the facility at any time without an adult. Children under 14 must be accompanied by a guardian at least 18 years of age for the entire visit to the pool. This is a CLAY COUNTY REQUIREMENT. Members and their guests must adhere to all pool rules (See

Time to Locate Your Pool Keys

If you never obtained your card, we have one for you. If you have lost your card, there is a \$25 replacement fee. If you are a new member since last summer, you will need a card. The former owner's card has been deactivated. If you are a renter, please call to verify your address as your card may have been deactivated.

You may obtain your card at the opening party on Saturday, May 27 from 11-2. After that day, contact D.D. Zimmerman at 816-509-1190.

Please note, your assessment must be paid in full to activate your key card. This includes late fees. Members with unpaid assessments are not allowed use of any community assets per Article III of our by-laws. This is enforced, and we have posted signs to make members aware that no one gets access to the pool without their own key card.

Please, remember to make sure the door shuts behind you after entering the facility to prevent nonmembers from entering.

You will be responsible for all clean up including putting away the big white tables (located in the ladies room), placing full bags of trash by the back door gate and putting furniture back in place. We will no longer be renting the facility for after-hours private parties due to lack of staff to secure and clean the facility.
